Plasterworks



About the workshop

We will be using the "direct carving" technique, the same technique as once used by the artisans of the Alhambra palaces. All this can be completed from home.

Process

- 1) The participants will first **stamp** a geometric pattern on a plaster tile.
- 2) Then they will **engrave** the piece with an engraving tool. Once the initial shape has been cut away, the student will then add texture or a personalized pattern.
- 3) Once the engraving work has been finished, we will then start on the **aged affect** of the plaster tile.

Who is it for?

This is a workshop for participants with **no prior artistic knowledge**. The material that we use is extremely versatile and allows for a **great finish**.

Wood Inlay



About the workshop

Originally the technique of the taracea combines wood with mother-of-pearl, ivory and silver to create mosaics to decorate boxes, chests and tables. Nowdays craftmen use materials that simulate the originals ones. Our class will stay true to the current techniques used by the craftsmen of Granada.

Process

- 1) Participants will first draw a **geometric pattern** on a sheet of wood.
- 2) Next we **measure** and **cut** the materials to prepare them to be put together according to a tracing done previously.
- 3) Once completed, we varnish the piece

Who is it for?

This is a class for **beginners without any previous experience**. The simple design allows all participants to achieve good results.

Tiles



About the workshop

This is an opportunity to take part in a unique activity in which participants learn about tile design with an innovating technique which perfectly imitates ceramic tile style used by Spanish Islamic craftsman without the use of a kiln.

Process

- 1) Tracing the **geometric design** of the Alhambra onto plaster/stucco.
- 2) Creating a carved 'bas-relief' piece.
- 3) Painting and incorporating colour combinations.
- 4) Finishing with the cleaning process for the perfect piece.

Who is it for?

As we employ a process without having to use a kiln, each participant has completed their own piece at he end of the session and it looks very similar to the original ceramic tiles.

Arabic Calligraphy



About the workshop

We offer a brief introduction to Arabic calligraphy using ancient traditional techniques that were of the utmost important to the Spanish-Muslim culture. **Epigraphic patterns are seen all around the Alhambra**. Nowadays, Arabic is the fifth most widely spoken language worldwide.

Process

Introduction to the Arabic alphabet. Participants will learn how to:

- 1) Pronounce and write basic Arabic lettering,
- 2) Use writing tools, Qalam (reed pen) and Indian Ink.
- 3) Translate and write the name of the participant on parchment.

Who is it for?

A workshop for people without any previous knowledge of Arabic that offers an educational experience through an artistic and cultural approach to this unique and prestigious trade.

Olive Oil



About the workshop

This activity will be held in our activities room in Granada, where we will explain the **production process** and hold the tasting sessions for our favourite Extra Virgin olive oils.

Process

- 1) Introduction to the (market, production process,...). **olive** oil world
- 2) Extra Virgin olive oil **characteristics**, olive oil **classification** and olive **varieties**.
- 3) Protocol and tasting session to appreciate the sensory characteristics of 3 extra virgin olive oils.

Who is it for?

This workshop is designed for all members of the public that share an interest in finding out more about Andalucia's «green gold«. This activity's interactive format teaches participants how to appreciate this healthy product, which is essential in the Mediterranean diet

Olive Oil Tour



About the workshop

This activity will be held at an "almazara" (oil press) so that participants can witness the production process first-hand during the olive-harvesting season (15/11 - 15/03).

We will visit the olive grove, speak with the workers and hold the tasting session at the Cooperative.

Process

- 1) Visit the olive grove to witness the olive harvest first-hand.
- 2) Learn about the stages of olive oil production at the mill's facilities.
- 3) Tasting session, sample 4 different extra virgin olive oils with the Maestro at the 'almazara' oil press.

Who is it for?

This workshop is designed for all all types of public that share an interest in finding out more about Andalucia's «green gold«. This activity's interactive format teaches participants how to appreciate the different stages of the manufacturing process and the tasting session at the press with the mill master will expose you to a whole range of sensations and make for an unforgettable interactive experience.

Spices Tasting



About the course

This activity will be held in our activities room in Granada, where participants engage all their senses: taste, smell, sight, hearing, and touch to discover the spices and plants cultivated and acclimatized during the Moorish period.

Process

- 1) Introduction to the the importance of Hydraulics, Agronomy and Botany in the Hispano-Muslim period,
- 2) Participants will have to grind different types of plants (cumin, cinnamon, aniseed,),
- 3) Blind tasting of 10 spices,
- 4) Tasting of Moorish sweets..

Who is this for?

This workshop is designed for students to grind and taste several plants to discover their culinary and medicinal properties.

Cooking Paella



About the course

Learn how to make a delicious, authentic paella served with your choice of meat and/or seafood infused with saffron. Our chef, will show you firsthand how to whip up this traditional Spanish dish.

Process

- 1) Heat up the olive oil and sauté your choice of meat or fish (or calamari and cuttlefish if applicable).
- 2) Add the minced garlic and your desired vegetables.
- 3) Add the Arborio (round-grain) rice, the paprika and the saffron.
- 4) Pour in the water or your choice of stock (chicken, beef or fish) and let simmer on low heat. If adding shellfish, add it in to the pan at this point as well.

Who is this for?

This online class is for those who have little or no cooking experience and would like to have a one of a kind culinary workshop. By the end of the class, you will know exactly how to make a delicious and flavorful paella.

What do we visit?:


